

REGISTRATION, FEES and POLICIES

Registration fees for adult and CNED classes are \$235. Registration allows students to receive member pricing at all Alliance Française events during the session. Books (textbook, workbook, 2 CDs) are an additional \$70.

Registration fees for Children's classes are \$175. This includes craft supplies and member pricing at all Alliance Française events during the session. Beginners 3 children's classes have a book fee of \$50.

Please register by mail, using the attached registration form, by **September 19, 2009**. All fees must be paid by check or money order to: **Alliance Française of Cincinnati**.

Late Payment: A late fee of \$20 will be charged for payments received after the first class.

Cancellation/Extra session: Classes without sufficient enrollment are subject to cancellation. We may add an additional session if necessary.

Refund policy: Due to our non-profit status and obligation to our instructors, class members and host association, no refunds after the first week of class.

Credit: In case of necessary withdrawal because of hardship beyond your control, you may apply for credit toward future instruction within the same school year. Contact the Director for information.

Make-up classes: In case severe weather or unexpected situations force us to cancel a class meeting, a make-up class will be added.

ABOUT OUR HISTORY

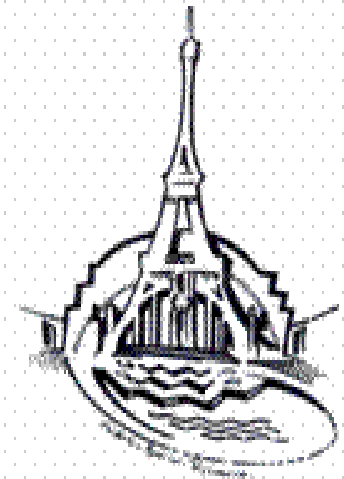

Course Offerings

We are proud to offer a wide variety of French language courses to suit your needs. Feel free to call if you have any questions about the course descriptions.

BEGINNERS 1 This level is suited to beginners of French or those who have had a little exposure to French years ago. Students in this class learn the basics of the French language and culture. Books: Add \$70

Monday 5:45—7:15 p.m. \$235

BEGINNERS 2 For students who have completed Beginners 1, or new students who have basic knowledge of French grammar (regular verbs, some irregular verbs, common vocabulary). Books: Add \$70

Wednesday 7:15—8:45 p.m. \$235

BEGINNERS 3 This course is designed for students who have completed Beginners 2, or who have had exposure to basic grammar and a growing number of irregular verbs. Books: Add \$70.

Monday 5:45—7:15 p.m. \$235

INTERMEDIATE 1 This class is designated for students who have completed our Beginners classes, or who have had French in the past and are comfortable in basic French but are ready to move on to more complicated grammar, such as reflexive verbs, past and future tenses and more conversational French. Books: Add \$70.

Monday 7:15—8:45 p.m. \$235

INTERMEDIATE 3 This class is for students who have completed Intermediate 1 and 2, or for new students who are becoming more comfortable using a variety of tenses and vocabulary in French. Books: Add \$70.

Monday 7:15—8:45 p.m. \$235

INTERMEDIATE 4 This class is for students who have completed Intermediate 3, have had exposure to some of the more complex French grammar such as the subjunctive mood. Students are more and more comfortable in spoken and written French. Books: Add \$70.

Wednesday 5:45—7:15 or 7:15—8:45 p.m. \$235

ADVANCED This course is designed for students who have completed the intermediate level of our coursework, or for the student who demonstrates strong control of French grammar and syntax and is comfortable in both conversational and reading French. Much of this class is devoted to reviewing advanced grammatical concepts and conversation. Books: Add \$70.

Wednesday 5:45—7:15 p.m. \$235

CHILDREN'S CLASSES at the ALLIANCE FRANCAISE: *We are proud to offer French classes for children starting at age 5.*

CHILDREN BEGINNERS 1: This class is for children just starting out in French. Children are immersed in the French language for 45 minutes, learning basic vocabulary and grammatical structures through crafts, games and songs. Fee includes supplies.

Saturday 11:15—12:00. \$140

CHILDREN BEGINNERS 2: This class is for children who have started in our program (or another) and have an exposure to basic vocabulary structures in French. Learning through listening and repeating, this class is completely oral /aural and there is no text. Fee includes supplies.

Saturday 10:05 a.m.—11:05 a.m. \$175

CHILDREN BEGINNERS 3 : This class is for children who have already had some exposure to written and spoken French, either in our program or in another. Children will work on listening, speaking, reading and writing in French, expanding their base of French vocabulary and basic French grammar. Fee includes supplies. Books: additional \$50.

Saturday 9:00 a.m.—10:00 a.m. \$175

CNED: This is a course designed for children of French ex-patriots and is specifically for native French speakers. The course begins in September and continues through the school year. Parents are asked to purchase books directly from the publisher in France.

Saturday 9:30 a.m.—11:00 a.m. \$235

TEXTBOOKS: A textbook as well as a workbook will be used in class. These materials include two listening CDs. Books may be purchased through the Institute for a total of \$70.

PRIVATE LESSONS: Private lessons are available at **\$50 per hour for one, \$70 per hour for two.** To schedule at your convenience please contact the director.
